- D. **Georgia Rural Center Housing Study** – Commissioner Tyrone Nelson moved to allow the Georgia Rural Center to conduct a housing study in Stewart County; seconded by Commissioner MaQuonzie Thomas. All voted in favor and motion carried. Vice-Chair Thomas Mayo moved to appoint John Morgan to complete Stonie Patterson term. All voted in favor and motion carried.
- F. **Camp Road Name Change** – The Stewart County Board of Commission unanimously approved to rename Camp Road to Haynes Road.
