**Reading and Approval of Minutes** – Commissioner Joe Lee Williams moved to approve both the March 10, 2026 Public Hearing minutes and the March 10, 2026 Regular minutes; seconded by Vice-Chair Thomas Mayo. All voted in favor and motion carried.


